
Thursday PE and Fitness Club

Torak Class information

This week in maths, we have been looking at using bar charts to present data. Firstly, applying a pictorial approach, the children created their own bar charts on large pieces of paper using multilink. They were then able to transfer their learning by drawing bar charts in their books.







We have been continuing our learning about China this week, looking at calligraphy. We discovered that in Ancient China only noble and royal children learnt calligraphy and it was viewed as one of the most important art forms. Torak class followed the five principles of Chinese calligraphy and created their own supreme visual arts.







Next week we are continuing to develop our knowledge of ancient Chinese art by looking at a variety of artists and recreating their style.

Mosi Class information

Well done to everyone in Mosi Class for your super work this week and for putting together a great class assembly. You all worked incredibly hard and should be proud of yourself for showing off your learning on The Shang Dynasty.

This week the children have brought together their topic and English learning to begin writing reference texts about The Shang Dynasty. Over the last two weeks we have investigated non-fiction texts and assessed them for their clarity and reliability and now the children are using their knowledge to create their own well-researched texts.

We have continued working on fractions in maths this week. Year 4 have been adding and subtracting fractions while Year 5 have moved onto ordering and comparing fractions with different denominators; learning first to change the fractions so that they have a common denominator. Meanwhile, Year 6 have begun to investigate algebra and have been working hard to solve simple algebraic equations.

It was wonderful to see such great homework again this week. I can see clearly that the children have enjoyed finding out about Chinese inventions and we were able to enjoy seeing their learning with some fantastic home-made ice-cream, green tea, kites, fireworks and even some models of toilets! (The ancient Chinese invented toilet roll).

Well done everyone for your hard work again this week. Have a lovely weekend.
